<u>Awards Committee</u> - Review/recommend to the Board of Directors any changes needed to the annual awards criteria and review nominations and select recipients for annual awards.

<u>Bylaws Committee</u> - Review Bylaws on an annual basis or as otherwise directed by the Board of Directors and to recommend to the Board of Directors any revisions/amendments to the Bylaws.

<u>Circle of Excellence Committee</u> - Review the application criteria; recommend to the Board of Directors any revisions; review all applications; communicate with applicants on any issues or questions; select recognition gifts (if any); coordinate the recognition program held at the Annual Awards Luncheon.

<u>Commercial Committee</u> (Open to Affiliates) - Exchange ideas, problems, solutions and listing information of commercial properties in the Columbus and surrounding areas; to recommend Commercial-related classes to the Education Committee; to coordinate with Circle of Excellence Chair on criteria and recognitions for Commercial Circle of Excellence.

<u>Communications/Public Relations Committee</u> (Open to Affiliates) - Positively promote the Association through media sources, disseminate event information and community involvement to GAR, NAR, and local news media within guidelines established by the Board of Directors.

<u>Education/Professional Development Committee</u> - Map out a balance of educational offerings. Determine the need for various areas of education and to determine the scope of demand as well as the available sources to provide such education.

<u>Entertainment Committee</u> (Open to Affiliates) Plan, promote and oversee all social functions that have been approved by the Board of Directors. This could include (but is not limited to): an annual ticketed Christmas event, Bingo and Family Fun Night.

<u>Equal Opportunity/Cultural Diversity Committee</u> (Open to Affiliates) Develop and recommend educational and awareness opportunities to promote equal opportunity in housing and diversity within the real estate industry.

<u>Legislative/Political/GARPAC Committee</u> - Encourage GARPAC investments. Keep members advised of all proposed changes in the Federal and State laws affecting the real estate industry or interests. Contact local, state, and federal government officials; encourage members to become involved. Promote the understanding of the function of the GARPAC committee.

<u>Membership Committee</u> - Solicit desirable applicants for Affiliate Membership in the Board, to promote the value of REALTOR Membership; to act on membership applications submitted to the Board for presentation to the Board of Directors each month.
